Over 370 dedicated athletes competed at the event across four different races to raise over £150,000 to support disadvantaged young people in the UK to succeed in education and employment. The Impetus-PEF Private Equity Triathlon, in association with the BVCA, now in its second year, provided a fantastic day out for professionals and their families from the private equity, venture capital and associated industries – including banking, accountancy, law, management consultancy, hedge funds and portfolio companies.
